



Learning for Discipleship

MISSION ON GOD'S WORLD

Mission in God's World is a ten-week course designed to give people an understanding of the fundamental principles of the Christian mission so that they can discern and contribute to the mission of the local church in their own community.

Key features of the course:

- ***mission as the activity of God in which He sends His servants***
- ***studying the New Testament to identify the key biblical principles of mission***
- ***how the Christian Church has understood its mission at different times***
- ***..... and in different parts of the world***
- ***the range of approaches to mission in the churches in this country today – e.g. Alpha and Emmaus courses, cell churches, Church Urban Fund, Mission-Shaped Church***
- ***tutor input, group work, visiting speakers, visual aids, private study, optional assignments***

Throughout the course those who take part are invited to reflect on the mission of their local church and their own calling in the light of what they are learning. In this way the course is designed to be of practical value in equipping people to share in the Christian mission.

It can be followed as a stand-alone course, or as a module within the **Learning for Discipleship** programme.
